There are currently over 20 projects underway to develop, improve and support automation to increase efficiency, employee motivation, and engagement. These projects range from project management to HR and recruiting, facilities management and communication tools.

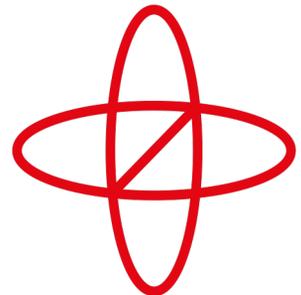

Sigma Software was therefore faced with the need to seamlessly integrate the two strategies so that they worked effectively without interfering with each other. 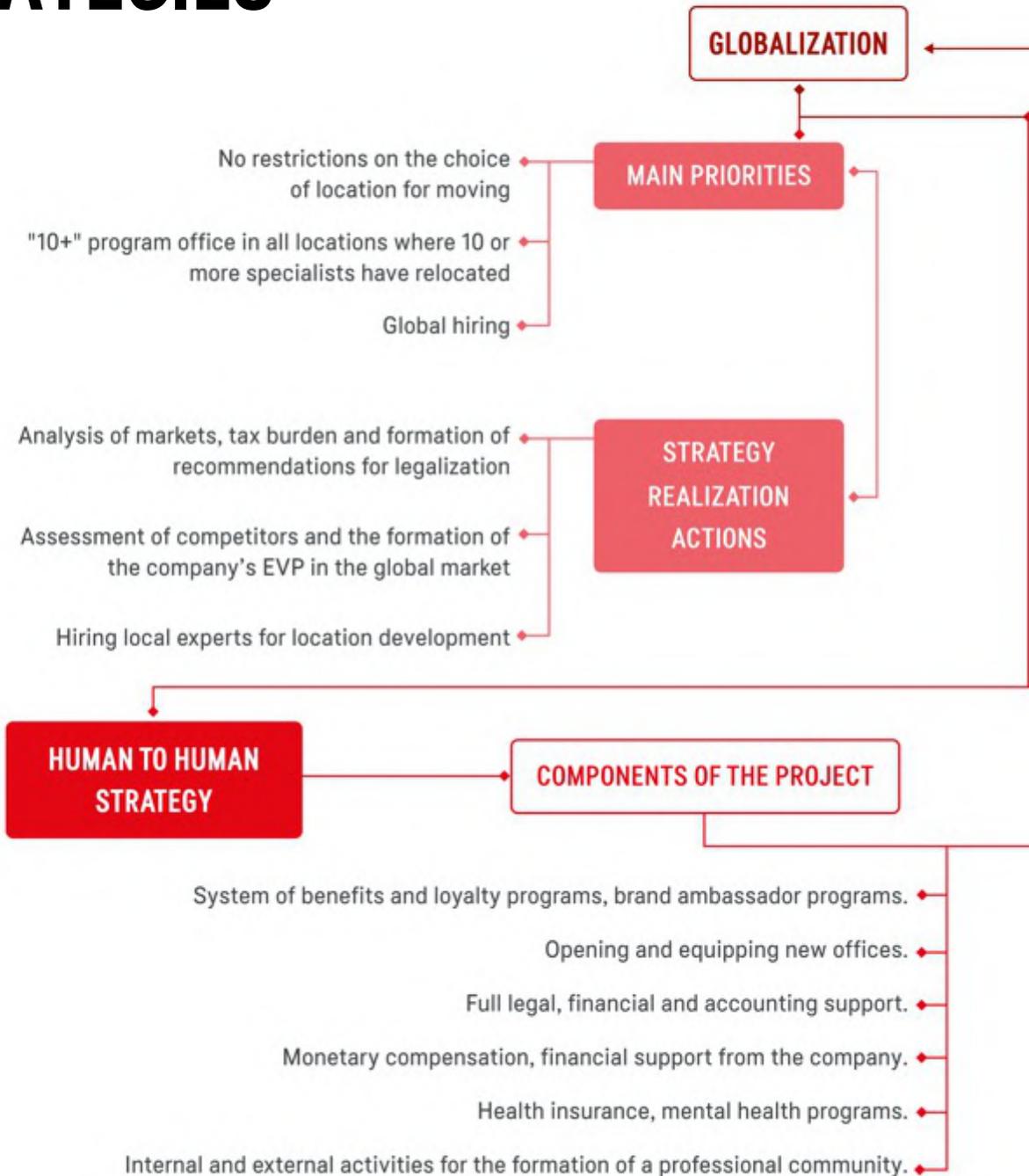

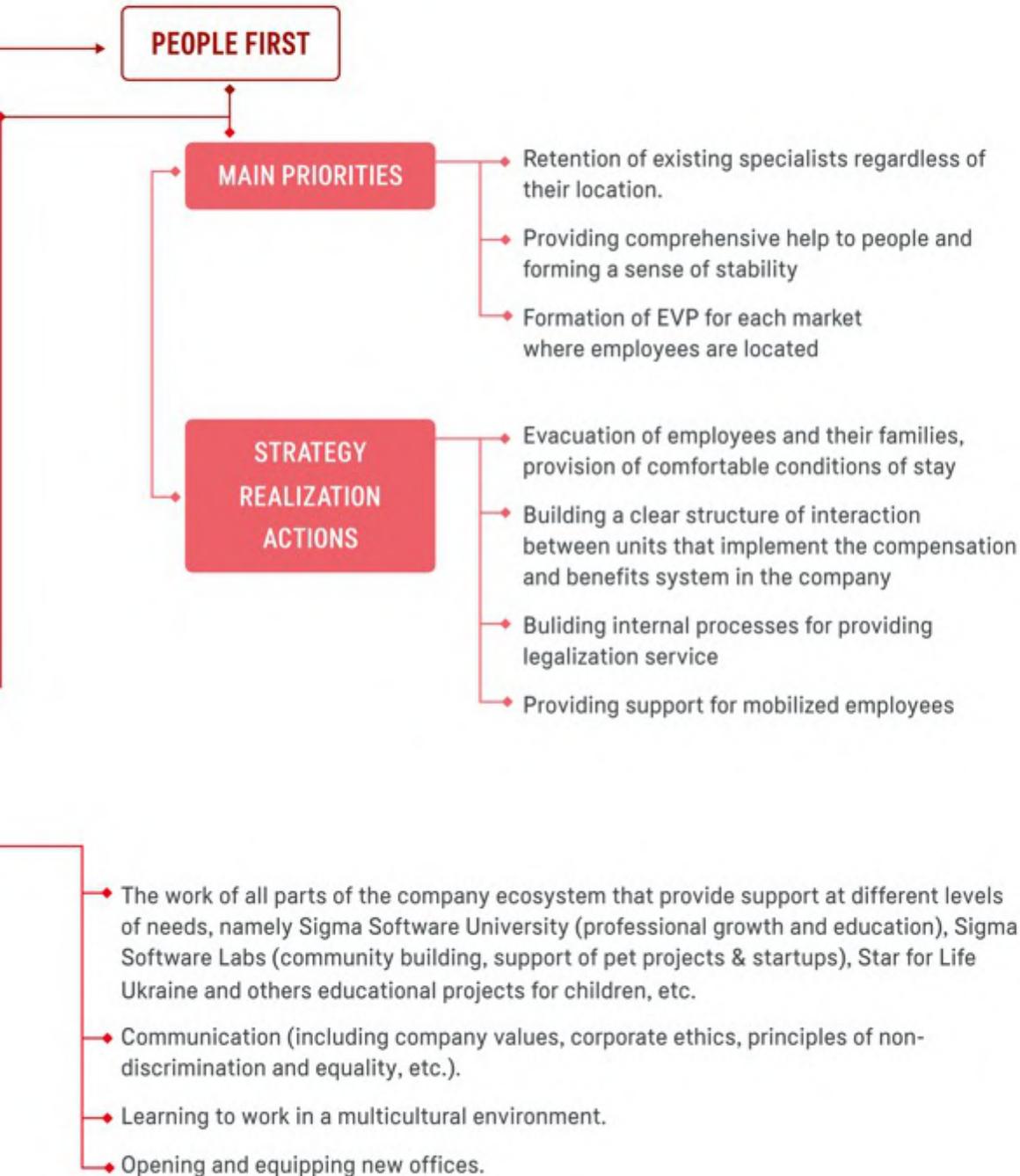

# INTEGRATING GLOBALIZATION AND PEOPLE FOCUSED STRATEGIES





# BASIC LEVEL

*The company organized the evacuation of more than 3,000 people: its specialists and their families.*

Temporary accommodation was provided for all those who had to move. Hotel stays for up to 5 days, company hotels in Ukraine, Poland, and Spain for several months, help in finding long-term accommodation, and rent compensation (500 people took advantage of this).

Providing decent working conditions was critical to the company's ability to deliver services to customers and keep its word. Temporary hubs were set up in company hotels, people were provided with the necessary equipment, while generators and Starlinks were purchased for all Ukrainian offices to ensure uninterrupted work.

All financial payments were made regularly and without delay. Specialists on low incomes received financial assistance from the company.

The company buys the necessary equipment for mobilized colleagues. All specialists continue to receive financial compensation and their jobs are protected.

# CONTINUOUS EDUCATION LEVEL

Despite the challenges, the company maintained all its professional assessment and growth practices.

The strong mentoring program, with over 300 mentors, helped each new team member easily adopt and clearly understand their career and development plans.

The Sigma Software University continued to provide various opportunities for professional training at the company's expense.

Building professional communities inside and outside the company helps promote knowledge sharing, strengthen networking, and intensify communication.

Since the outbreak of hostilities, the company has run several courses on the basics of testing, programming, HR, and recruitment for family members of specialists who lost their jobs as a result of the war. Shortly after the start of the war, we resumed classes in programs for beginners: camps and internships in the directions: NODE. JS, Angular, Java, PHP, Big Data, Support, .NET, GameDev, UI/UX and others.

# SOCIAL LEVEL

On a social level, Sigma Software has provided employees with office space (opening 17 new offices worldwide) for comfortable working and networking, revived all office traditions, engaged people in communities by interest, and provided support to ensure mental health and work-life balance.

The company supports local traditions in all offices: breakfasts, Christmas get-togethers, sports activities, and children's events to prevent employees from feeling lonely and distressed.

Involvement in volunteering and pro-bono projects is also an effective way for people to take their minds off their problems and make new connections.



# PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Internal training has always been one of the company's priorities. Over the years, we have organized courses and training that have become increasingly comprehensive, and one day in 2017 this led to the official launch of our continuous education program.

We aimed to ensure the professional development of our employees from Junior to Middle and then from Middle to Senior and to make this growth more predictable and controlled.

In addition, the program aimed to make the specific needs of each specialist clearer to managers and HR and to make their career and professional path more transparent.

Continuous education is one of the three main directions of Sigma Software University.



# MAIN FIGURES IN 2023

- Over 600+ internal educational events including general workshops and courses, English groups, etc.
- 4908 participants underwent training (+135% compared to 2022).
- Satisfaction with educational courses in 2023 is 80% (very satisfied and satisfied).

# INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS TO MAKE HR WORK MORE EFFICIENT

In order to adapt the company's EVP to a significantly wider footprint and to ensure that specialists in all locations have the same opportunities, **Sigma Software introduced the Global EVP Assistant.**

Developed by our specialists, it helps gather in one place all the information about 19 different EVP packages adapted to different locations, make it easily accessible and transparent, automate the work of HR, lawyers and accountants, and also ensure an individual approach to each employee with fewer human errors.

The creation of a single system allowed all information and processes related to benefits, country of residence, personal nuances, work calendar, etc. to be combined and presented in a clear way. Automated data collection, analysis, notifications, built-in tools and integration with other company systems significantly improve the experience of employees using HR services.

The project was awarded by HR Brand Ukraine on Digital HR Nomination.



# GLOBAL EVP ASSISTANT IN FIGURES

- 19 relevant, localized, and customized packages for equal opportunities.
- 80% reduction in questions from employees due to transparent, open, and accessible information about their benefits and opportunities.
- A bespoke dashboard reduced the time spent managing the health insurance process by a factor of 2.
- Integration between the systems enabled the work of HR specialists to be optimized by 60% and the risk of error to be significantly reduced.
- The creation of the Global EVP Assistant enabled the number of correspondence between functions regarding employee benefits to be reduced to 0.
- The average level of satisfaction with the new Global EVP Assistant system, based on the results of the completed feedback form, is 4.7 out of 5.



# COMMUNICATION

Communication is an important and integral part of Sigma Software's strategy.

We use secure channels to keep the team around the world up to date with the latest news and initiatives, the status of business development and achievement of business objectives, information on values and policies, opportunities, and benefits.

Ongoing communication has enabled us to build a high level of trust and loyalty among our professionals.

Regular communication helps to reduce uncertainty, gives people more confidence, and ultimately brings the company closer to achieving its goals.

Sigma Software encourages two-way communication and is keen to hear the opinions and ideas of its specialists, as well as their fears. We do this through regular meetings with the company's management, where anyone can ask questions, and by promoting our Facebook Workplace channel, which provides various opportunities to express their thoughts.

We use a variety of channels to reach our employees around the world.

Internal communities are a powerful tool, giving employees the opportunity to be heard and to make more peer-to-peer connections.

To help people take their minds off the problems they face, we encourage our specialists to create communities that engage like-minded people.

- 10+ internal communities by interests.
- The cooking community unites people for common cooking sessions and office traditions like regular breakfasts. 500 participants.
- Sports Community unites participants of yearly sports challenges, runners, tennis fans, company`s sporting teams. Over 100 active participants.
- Knowledge-sharing community that gathers over 200 activists for regular webinars.
- Trainers club is a community for networking and knowledge sharing among mentors and trainers at internal and external educational events. Over 100 participants.
- Creativity Community unites those, who would like to explore all facets of their own creativity (music, singing, painting, etc.). Over 300 participants.

# MENTAL HEALTH

Since the beginning of 2022, the company started to hold webinars with professional psychologists for specialists on various issues: from returning to an effective state to issues of living together with relatives and parents, as many specialists were forced to relocate with family members and live under one roof.

- **19** group sessions.
- Over **50** hours.
- **50** professionals supported.
- Every employee can receive compensation for seeing a psychologist.

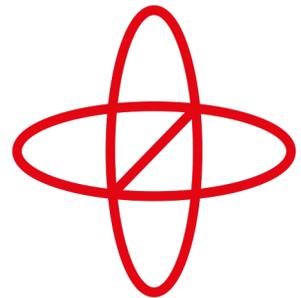

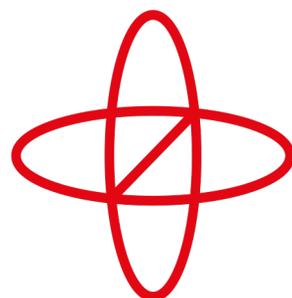

# UNICORN STARTUP COMPETITION

One of the notable projects contributing to the development of the startup community is the UNICORN startup competition.

Since 2013, the competition has been organized by Sigma Software and partners under the name IT EUREKA Ukraine. Initially, it was aimed at student startups, but eventually, it expanded and welcomed all startup teams to participate. Since 2022, the competition has become international.

In 2023, the contest changed its name and identity to UNICORN.

The format of the competition includes an intensive training and acceleration program for the participants, involving industry leaders as mentors and speakers.

The main goal of the competition is to create conditions for the development of startups in Ukraine and Europe, to gather a dedicated community, and to provide comprehensive support and educational components to promote the growth of the projects after the program.

The year 2022 will forever remain the blackest in the life of every Ukrainian. As a socially responsible company headquartered in Kharkiv with more than two thousand Ukrainian specialists, Sigma Software wanted to support and uplift the spirit of Ukrainians through Ukrainian art and talent.

Together with the galleries "Painted Fox", "Art UA", BF "Always Ukraine" and the largest shopping center in Western Ukraine, Victoria Gardens, we organized an art festival that brought together the best artists from 25 regions of Ukraine and created a powerful mural "United by Victories".

The result was so powerful and beautiful that we decided to go beyond the wall and present these artworks to the whole of Ukraine.

As a separate brand, Sigma Software University was launched in 2016.

The University has three main directions:

- The first is an internal training and mentoring program within the company.
- The second is a partnership with educational institutions, improving the educational programs of universities, working with students, internships, and camps for those who have no experience or are just starting out in IT.
- The third is external courses covering different technologies, specialties (both technical and non-technical), and professional levels.

Despite the invasion, the university continued to work intensively, participating in the projects of the Ministry of Digital Transformation, launching free courses for those who lost their jobs due to the war, working to improve the qualifications of teachers, etc. Currently, Sigma Software University is working in Sweden, Israel, Saudi Arabia, Poland, and Georgia and is establishing relations with Germany and Tanzania.

# WORKING WITH UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES

As a socially responsible company, Sigma Software is actively involved in many student activities and participates in the educational process. We firmly believe that it is only through the joint efforts of business and educational institutions that we will be able to train the specialists we need. A solid theoretical base gained at modern universities combined with practical experience gained during training programs in IT companies can bring really good results.

- Currently, Sigma Software University cooperates with more than **50** universities, colleges, and IT schools in Ukraine and abroad.
- **100+** events for students every year. In 2023, we engaged more than **8000** participants in **120+** events and received **95%** positive feedback.

The company also runs a professional development program for academic staff. The Teacher's SmartUp project is now in its second year. Twice a year, 5-day intensive sessions are held on topics ranging from technology trends to soft skills development and business approaches. In 2023, 1,598 participants attended the events and were very active, with 98% giving positive feedback.

# SUPPORTING EDUCATION ON ALL LEVELS

Sigma Software specialists take part in joint projects with schools, act as speakers at children's events, contribute to the development and implementation of career guidance programs, and update computer science programs. The company helps to equip computer labs in schools so that children can learn on modern computers.

In 2023, we joined the project initiated by the Ministry of Digital Transformation of Ukraine. As part of the project, Sigma Software experts with practical experience in various areas of the IT sphere took part in the discussion of the content lines of computer science education in schools and gave practical recommendations for its renewal. One of the components of the pilot project "Updated Informatics - IT Studios" was the preparation of videos for teaching informatics. Sigma Software participated in the creation of such videos together with other members of the IT community.



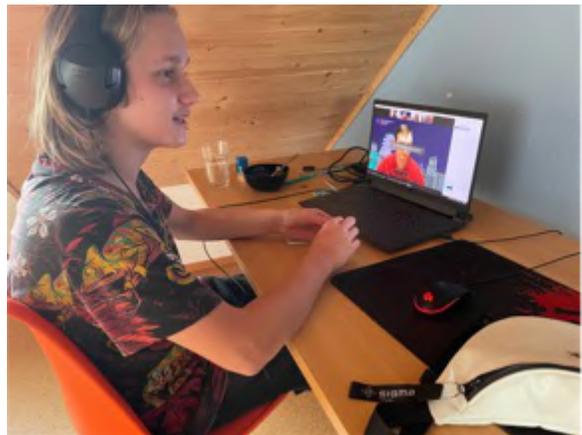
# CODE DAYS FOR EMPLOYEES' CHILDREN

The trend in recent years has been for IT professionals to mature, with the **25-30** and **31-40** age groups being the largest.

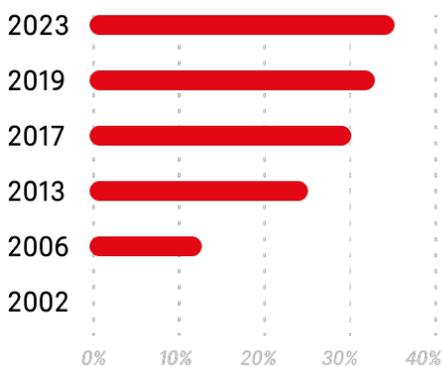

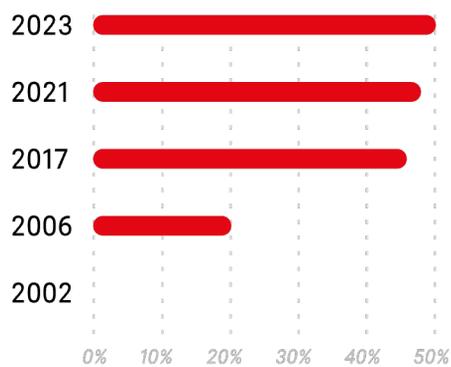

# FEMMEGINNERING PROJECT

Sigma Software continues to work on attracting women to the IT industry and in 2021, together with the Danir Group, we've developed the Femmeginnering project, which aims to build a female IT community and inspire women to join the tech industry by sharing success stories, launching educational events, providing free access to IT training and mentoring by industry leaders.

In 2021, our amazing professionals shared their stories of becoming developers and managers. These stories helped many girls and young women to follow their passion for IT and ignore the prejudices and stereotypes they may still face in society and even in their families.

In 2022-2023, we decided to strengthen the project and expand it to the emerging European tech markets. The company organized meetups for women in Poland, Bulgaria, Ukraine, and Brazil, attracting high-profile experts from leading tech companies. Topics included software testing, career development, project management, business analysis, etc.

In 2023, Sigma Software was awarded the Partnership for Sustainability Award 2023 by UN Global Compact Ukraine for its efforts in building equality and gender balance through the Femmegeneering project.

We also support the STEM girls community through mentoring and meetings.

# GENDER PARITY IS A WINNING BUSINESS STRATEGY

*Gender parity in the IT sector is something I am very interested in. Unfortunately, women make only 25% of workers in the tech industry according to research conducted by Women In Tech Network, which is the world's leading organization for inclusion, diversity and equity in STEM. Furthermore, women make only 11% of workers at the executive level in tech companies. What is most shocking to me is the fact that 1 in 5 women working in tech admits wanting to leave this industry because they feel bullied, underappreciated, and always passed over for promotions. The good news is that many companies are now making an effort to change this trend and encourage women to advance their careers in tech.*

Gender parity is a winning business strategy for all companies regardless of the field. Having women at managerial and executive levels in tech companies can bring about several benefits, including:

- **Diverse Perspectives and Innovation:** Women often have different life experiences, viewpoints, and problem-solving approaches compared to their male counterparts. When women are represented in managerial and executive roles, they bring diverse perspectives to the decision-making process. This diversity of thought can lead to more innovative solutions, creative problem-solving, and a broader range of ideas. Different viewpoints can help identify opportunities and challenges that might not have been considered otherwise, fostering a culture of continuous improvement and innovation within the company.
- **Improved Company Culture and Employee Satisfaction:** Gender diversity at leadership levels sends a positive message to all employees, regardless of their gender. It demonstrates that the company values inclusivity, equal opportunities, and a fair work environment. This inclusive culture can contribute to higher employee morale, increased job satisfaction, and better retention rates. When employees see women in leadership roles, they are more likely to believe that their contributions will be recognized and rewarded based on merit, leading to a more motivated and engaged workforce.
- **Enhanced Decision-Making and Problem Solving:** Research has shown that diverse teams make better decisions and solve complex problems more effectively. Having women in managerial and executive positions helps prevent groupthink and fosters a culture of healthy debate and constructive dissent. When individuals from various backgrounds collaborate and contribute their unique insights, the decision-making process becomes more robust and balanced. This ultimately leads to better strategic choices, reduced blind spots, and a higher likelihood of achieving successful outcomes.

Incorporating women into managerial and executive roles in tech companies is not only a matter of gender equality but also a strategic advantage that can drive innovation, strengthen company culture, and improve overall business performance.

Achieving complete gender parity in the tech industry remains a challenge, and no single tech company can be definitively said to have achieved perfect gender equality at all levels. Addressing the barriers causing the inequality between men and women in tech requires concerted efforts from tech companies, educational institutions, policymakers, and society at large. Initiatives focused on diversity and inclusion, unbiased hiring practices, mentorship, and sponsorship programs, and creating supportive work environments are essential for achieving gender equality in the tech industry.

However, some tech companies have made notable efforts to improve gender diversity and create a more inclusive environment. Sigma Software is among them. We were nominated as best place to work for Women in Tech! Moreover, we have achieved gender parity at managerial level. Finally, Sigma is becoming global and there is commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion.

# DECIDED TO LEARN SIGN LANGUAGE TO COMMUNICATE WITH DEAF PEOPLE AND HELP THEM BUILD A CAREER IN IT

*Once I realized that being able to use sign language would be of great benefit both to me as a professional and to help deaf people with careers in the IT field, because there is a lot of undiscovered talent among them.*

*During my studies, I met many amazing deaf people with even more amazing stories. There are many talented and smart people among them, but unfortunately, the rest of the world can't see them because they are often rejected. Perhaps now is the time for employers and recruitment specialists to open their eyes to them. Also, I'm trying to help other deaf people find a job by advising, mentoring and helping them with their CVs.*

While collaborating with differently abled people, I met a person in a wheelchair who was also blind. He certainly has a hard life, needing constant help. But even so, I was impressed by how intelligent he was. He reads a lot of books, uses a computer and writes articles. He has excellent language skills and translates books from several languages. And also makes podcasts and records audiobooks. And he told me that doing all this keeps him alive and happy and helps him see meaning in life – motivation of that magnitude is often lacking in people without health problems.

I believe that people with hearing or vision problems could do well in many IT-related occupations as anyone else if they had an equal chance to be trained, mentored and accepted by their employers and colleagues. And this opens up a whole new market for my colleagues in HR.

# TRAINING

To adapt to the challenges of globalization, the Sigma Software team reviewed internal processes and policies to ensure that they covered all aspects of diverse and multicultural practices.

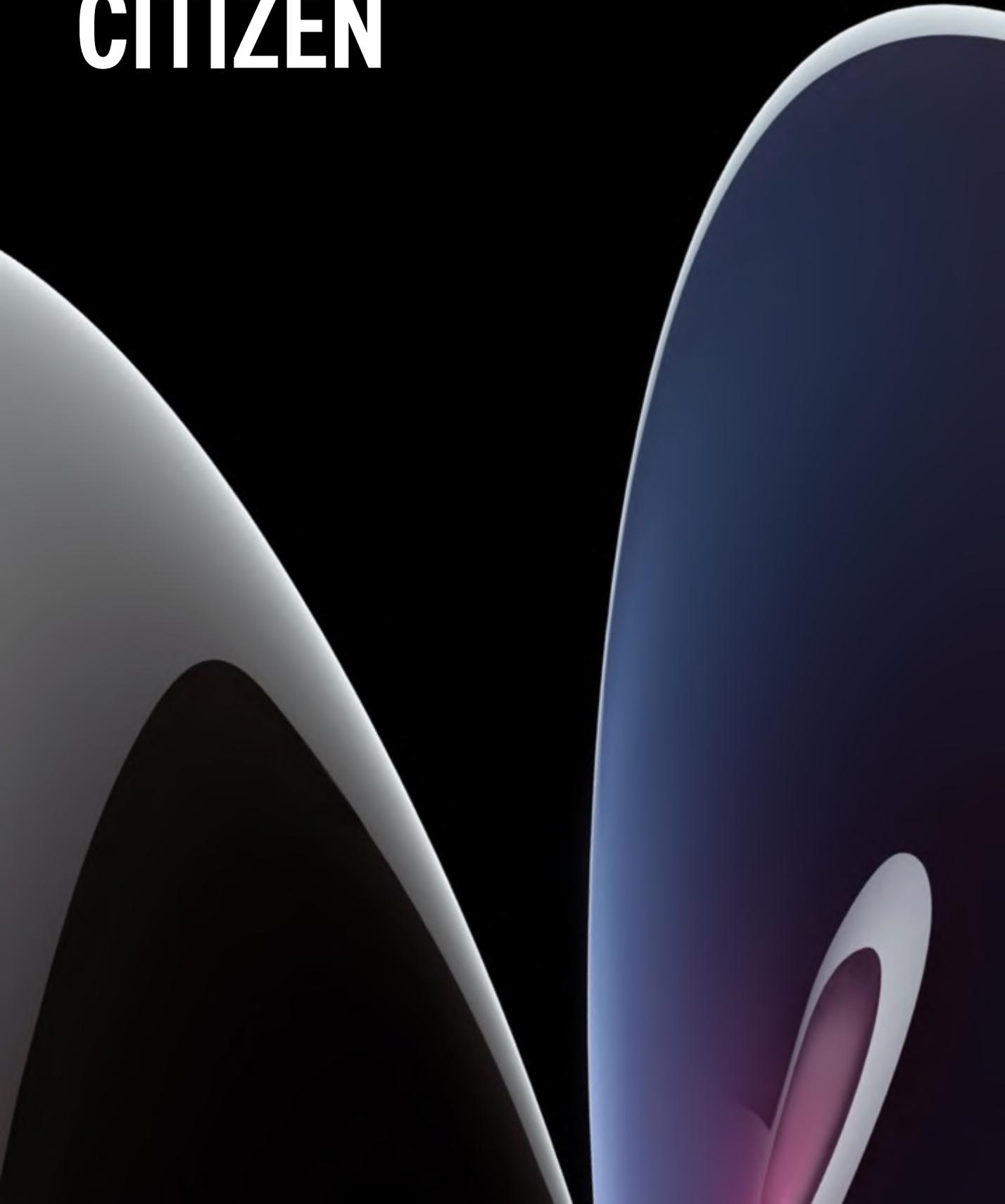

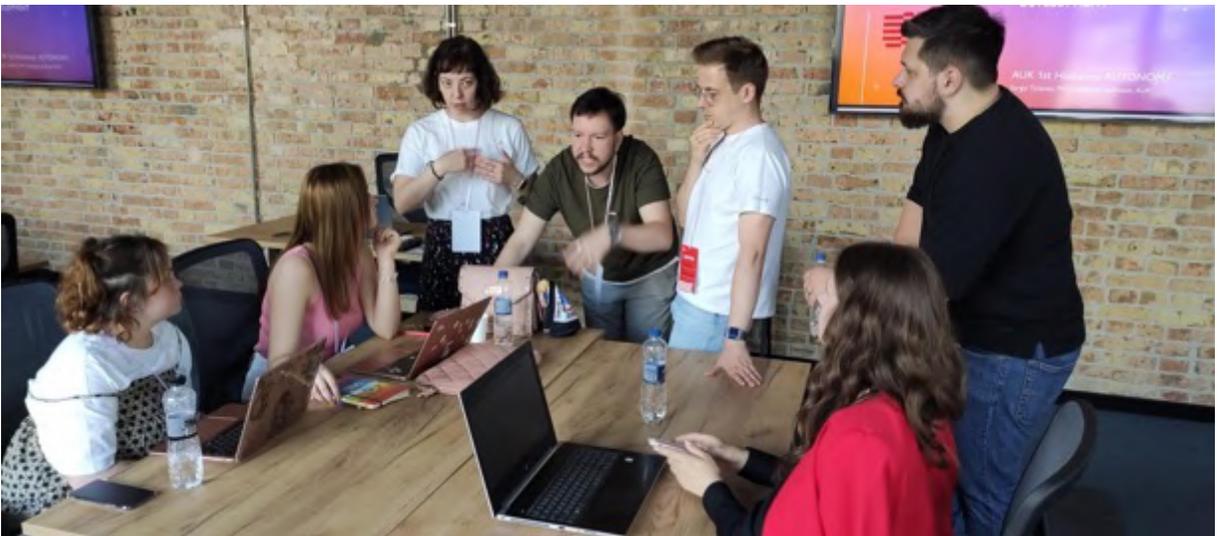

# VOLUNTEERING

With the beginning of the full-scale war in Ukraine, the development and support of the volunteer community became as important for the company as the support of the technical and professional community.

In addition to establishing the Sigma Software Unity Fund, which helps civilians and defenders of the country, the company supports the volunteer movement and participates in volunteer projects (charity fairs in cooperation with Harley Davidson, ridden by one of our colleagues, charity stand-up evenings at Sigma Software offices, art exhibitions in Ukrainian and European cities to raise people's spirits and funds to help Ukrainians, joint projects with influencers, etc.). The company's specialists are also happy to participate in pro-bono projects.

Regular and transparent internal communication keeps people informed about current volunteering projects and the results of joint work to raise funds for charity, implement ecological initiatives, contribute to educational projects, etc.



# CHATBOT FOR KHARKIV

Sigma Software works with the authorities of Kharkiv, a city of 1.5 million people located just 30 kilometers from the Russian border.

In 2022, the company helped the city create a chatbot that allows residents to track the extent of damage caused by Russian aggression. The bot provides information about the status of damage and the state of utilities: availability of electricity, water supply, etc.

In 2023, the project, which Sigma Software joined on a pro-bono basis, continues to evolve. Several new features have been added to the chatbot: viewing photos of damaged buildings, checking the status of applications for compensation for the restoration of damaged property, and finding directions to the nearest shelter or resilience center.

# SMART CITY CONCEPT FOR KHARKIV

In 2023, representatives of Sigma Software, Kharkiv IT Cluster, and other Kharkiv-based IT companies joined the working group for the development of Kharkiv and developed the concept of Smart City, which implies the construction of new infrastructure in the existing districts that suffered from Russian aggression, and even the construction of new infrastructure.

Valery Krasovsky, CEO and co-founder of Sigma Software became a unique point of contact for the Smart City project.

Smart City is a holistic concept of intelligent integration of the latest technologies into all aspects of citizens' lives. The project is not only about creating infrastructure but also about creating a new lifestyle and mindset, and mutually respectful and trustworthy relationships between residents and city services.

The project includes the construction of a new smart neighborhood equipped with a single IoT network, safe smart bus stops with traffic tracking systems, smart traffic lights, smart car parks with electric car charging stations, automatic water and electricity meters, automatic lighting, automatic garbage collection, smart video surveillance systems, equipped shelters and more.



# PROFESSIONAL TRAINING FOR MILITARY ENGINEERS

Sigma Software University has launched a program of free professional training for IT engineers in military service. They can improve their IT qualifications by attending training programs and courses developed by qualified instructors and Sigma Software specialists. Self-study materials are also available on the Sigma Software University online platform.

# SNIFF PROJECT

In 2021 and 2022, a student project idea was born, which later developed into an interesting framework. The results of this framework will soon be presented to the company. It also became a donation project for several educational initiatives, including IT Generation, which is supported by the company.

The project aimed to help homeless animals affected by war. The idea was to create a platform where different users from all over Ukraine, as well as relevant organizations, could share photos and exchange contact and location information about animals that were suffering from the war or had lost their owners and needed help or care.

Throughout the development of the project, 49 interns have been involved in various stages of its creation. Some of them were subsequently employed by the company or found jobs in the market. Several foreign developers were also involved in the development of the project.

In addition, 9 mentors were able to develop and practice project setups that they were unable to do or were limited in doing on their current projects. The project is scheduled to be released in its final form in December 2023, but there are plans for further development and enhancements. The organization's team is looking forward to the possibility of returning to the project in the future.
